

IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ

For Park Patrons with Reservations

THANK YOU for choosing a City of Kannapolis Park!

In order to keep the park safe and clean, we ask everyone to follow these guidelines during your visit.

At Bakers Creek, when the parking lot is full you will need to park behind the tennis courts. The gravel drive on the right hand side of the tennis courts will take you to the overflow grass parking area. Vehicles parked in non-authorized areas may be towed. Please do not block the flow of traffic in the parking lot. Any vehicle that is improperly parked may be towed at owner's expense.

At Village Park, when on street parking is full, please use the Village Park Building lot or proceed to the YMCA OVERFLOW lot, across Mountain Street.

Please use only TAPE or STRING to put up decorations. NO staples, tacks, pushpins, nails, etc. --- they all cause damage to wood. Please, no piñatas.

After your event, please remove all decorations and tape. All trash should be placed in cans. Park staff will empty the cans.

Please have your event over at the end of your scheduled time. Late fees may be imposed and future reservations not allowed if rules are not followed.

No alcohol is allowed in the Park. Alcohol use by anyone in your group will result in your entire group being asked to leave. Please monitor your group.

Music and noise levels should be kept to a minimum. You will be asked to turn off any loud music that disturbs other groups.

NO HOT OIL cooking of any kind. Groups will be asked to leave and no future reservations will be taken under the contact name. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Vehicles will NOT be allowed to drive to any shelter for any reason. At Bakers Creek, no vehicle will be allowed to park in the yellow FIRE LANE at the end of the parking lot for any reason. Safety and insurance regulations prohibit vehicles from operating outside of driveways and designated areas. Arrange with your group to have help to unload/load your vehicles.

At Bakers Creek, a valid photo I.D. will need to be left at the concession stand when you are checking out sports equipment. There IS a fee for miniature golf. Sports equipment and Putt-Putt are available ONLY during normal concession hours. You may want to bring your own horseshoes, basketball and volleyball.

Shelter fees are non-refundable. No refunds will be given with notice of cancellation made less than 15 days prior to requested reservation. No refunds will be given for inclement weather, however, we will try to work with your group to reschedule your event.

You are the contact person for the group. Please let your party know of these rules. Please help us keep your park clean and safe for years to come.
