Elder Orphan Care works with older adults age 60+ in Rowan and Cabarrus counties who are disadvantaged due to lack of income or resources and/or who may be aging alone. We perform occupational therapy-based home safety assessments and provide minor home modifications and/or adaptive equipment as we are able to allow our clients to age at home in a safer and more accessible environment.

We provide a monthly pantry service with groceries delivered free of charge to our clients who qualify. We have recently started an adapted tablet pilot program providing qualifying clients a tablet and 1 year of service to allow access to community, virtual programming, and daily wellness checks with us.
